

SHOPPER TIPS

WOLFF'S FLEA MARKET

ARRIVE EARLY

By arriving early you can take advantage of first offerings and larger selections. You will have more time to browse, compare prices and merchandise.

FINDING YOUR WAY AROUND

Make sure to walk the entire market. Row and Space Numbers are stenciled on the ground in blue. Row markers are set up as well. East side = *Single Letter Rows* (A1, A2, etc.) and West side = *Double Letter Rows* (AA1, AA2, etc.).

You will find new merchandise, garage sale, jewelry, produce, antiques, vintage clothing, thrift, collectibles and more up down every aisle. And remember, if you walk by every booth (both sides of the aisle), you have walked over *3 miles!*

IF YOU LOVE IT...

Buy it before it's gone!

REFUNDS

When purchasing an item, ask vendor about their return policy. They may determine their own protocol. Liquidation, garage sale, antique and collectible merchandise is usually sold "as is".

CHECK ELECTRICAL ITEMS BEFORE LEAVING

Electrical outlets are located near the food area at the SW corner of the Arena. You can test your electrical item(s) to see if they are in proper working order.

SHOULD YOU HAGGLE?

Some vendors may come down a little in their price. When in doubt, ask anyway-there's no harm done. Vendors are people too; please be kind, as politeness will help you negotiate. Sometimes buying in volume allows for a discounted price.

PLAN AHEAD WHEN BUYING A LARGE ITEM

Think about how to get larger items home. Most sellers don't deliver. But appliance or new mattress vendors might. Some may have a warehouse where you can pick up your purchase at a later time. Bring a tape measure to help you figure out if your purchase fits into your vehicle or the space where you plan to place it in your home.



DELIVERY

Wolff's offers pick up of large items from a vendor's spot and will deliver to your car for a nominal fee. Note the Space Number and request this service by the Information Desk.

BURIED TREASURE

When shopping for garage sale items or even new merchandise, make sure you look behind and under what is displayed. You may find hidden treasures!

KNOW WHAT YOU WANT, BUT BE OPEN TO SURPRISES

If you have limited time, know what you are looking for. Chances are you'll find it! Even though you may have something specific in mind, if you are alert, you may be surprised by an unexpected find!



BRING CASH

Some vendors accept credit cards, online payments and others are "cash and carry". Small bills will be helpful in paying for items as well as haggling. 2 ATMs are available at the entrance to the building.



WEAR THE RIGHT CLOTHING FOR THE WEATHER

Walking shoes are a must when shopping the seemingly endless rows of bargains at Wolff's.
